- Q1) A stadium has 20 rows of seats with 50 seats in each row. How many seats are there in total?
- Q2) If you have 16 packs of 24 crayons each, how many crayons do you have in total?
- Q3) A classroom has 9 tables, and each table has 6 chairs. How many chairs are there in the classroom?
- Q4) A cinema has 18 rows of seats with 20 seats in each row. How many seats are there in total?
- Q5) If a book costs \$15 and you buy 14 books, how much will you spend in total?
- Q6) A baker uses 5 eggs for each cake. How many eggs are needed to bake 24 cakes?
- Q7) A printer prints 120 pages per hour. How many pages can it print in 5 hours?
- Q8) A school bus has 18 seats in 6 rows. How many seats are there in total?
- Q9) A factory packs 250 boxes every day. How many boxes will it pack in 10 days?
- Q10) If a car travels 65 miles per hour, how many miles will it travel in 6 hours?
- Q11) A library has 12 shelves with 90 books on each shelf. How many books are there in total?
- Q12) If you buy 30 packs of pens and each pack contains 12 pens, how many pens do you have in total?

1) $20 \times 50 = 1000$ seats

2) $16 \times 24 = 384$ crayons

3) $9 \times 6 = 54$ chairs

4) $18 \times 20 = 360$ seats

5) $15 \times 14 = \$210$

6) $5 \times 24 = 120$ eggs

7) $120 \times 5 = 600$ pages

8) $18 \times 6 = 108$ seats

9) $250 \times 10 = 2500$ boxes

10) $65 \times 6 = 390$ miles

11) $12 \times 90 = 1080$ books

12) $30 \times 12 = 360$ pens
